

Diffuser removal and cleaning

Before starting, please ensure that you are standing on a steady platform and you can reach the diffuser without risk of falling.

You will be able to see around the edge of the diffuser that there are three indentations. These are the points at which the tabs of the diffuser insert into the white ceiling ring slots. Select one of the fixing points (e.g. 1 on fig.1) and, using your finger, gently prise the diffuser tab out its slot in the ceiling ring. As you prise the tab out of the ceiling ring, ease it down slightly so that it doesn't slip back into the ceiling ring slot. Now repeat this with the next tab (2 on fig 1).

If the diffuser has been in place for some time, it may be that you need to work your way around the diffuser several times as the lens will have settled into position. Please be patient and don't be tempted to force the lens tabs as it can be broken.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES TRY AND REMOVE THE DIFFUSER USING A TOOL LIKE A SCREW DRIVER AS YOU WILL DAMAGE THE UNIT.

When the first two tabs are free the final tab can be manoeuvred out of the ceiling ring and the diffuser lens can be removed for cleaning. Please keep a tight hold of the lens as it can break if dropped.

When cleaning, a dry cloth is normally sufficient to remove any dust or debris. Please avoid any abrasive cleaning tools or chemical cleaners. If you do decide to wipe it using a wet cloth or rinse the diffuser in water, allow it to fully air-dry before reinserting.

DO NOT CLEAN THE DIFFUSER IN A DISHWASHER.

To reinsert the diffusing lens just reverse the process. Make sure the foam seal is in place and located evenly around the base of the tube. Offer the lens up to the base of the tube and ensure that the foam seal is seated evenly inside it. Now ease the lens up into place and individually locate each tab into its slot in the ceiling ring. Sometimes this may take two or three attempts to get it in place with the foam correctly located – **do not try and force the tabs into position as they can be broken.**




